HOLOGRAPHIC WILLSCHECKLIST

What is a Holographic Will?

A holographic will is a handwritten will that is signed and dated by a person in their personal handwriting.

What that means is that if you take pen to paper and write out your wishes, such as: "I want Susie to get my house when I die, John to get my dog, and Jane to get my antiques, and my car", it can be a valid will under Nevada law.

The key here is that the will must be in the will maker's handwriting.

A typed up will that is signed but does not follow the rules for wills under Nevada law will not be valid as a holographic will.

What is required for a valid Holographic Will?

A valid holographic will <u>must have</u>:

	A date
	Your signature
	A title or words to indicate your intent for the
	document to be your Will.
	Who is to get what assets – e.g. "I give my son
	Bob Smith my 2011 Blue Mustang, and I give my
	daughter, Jane Smith everything else I own."
	All of the above written in your own handwriting
	(not typed)

valid holographic will <u>should have</u> :		
	Your full name and all other names you have used;	
	Your place of residence;	
	Your marital status, naming present spouse, if any;	
	The names of all your children, whether alive,	

deceased, or adopted. It is important to include even those children to whom nothing will be left so there is no confusion.
